The Training and Placement Cell, JNTUH University College of Engineering Sultanpur, organized a seminar on "Skills for the Future IT Workforce".



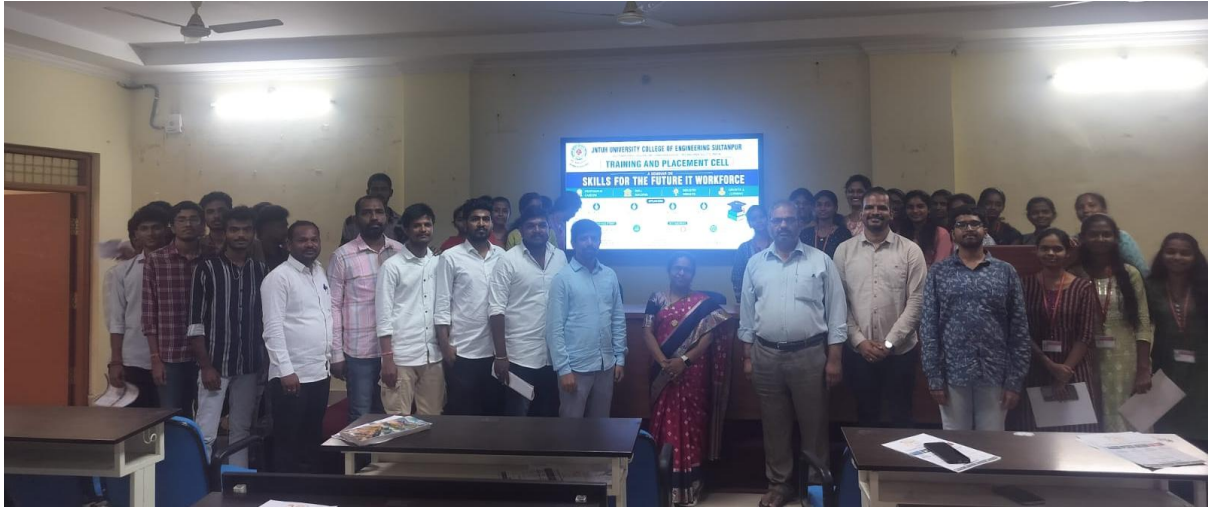
